

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The following terms and conditions relate to Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Councils Enchanted Winter Garden event.

For safety reasons parts of Antrim Castle Gardens will be closed to public access daily from Friday 7th December – Tuesday 18th December 2018. Some areas may be closed prior to these dates to facilitate the build of the Enchanted Winter Garden. The main car park at Antrim Castle Gardens will be closed from 3pm as per dates above.

Entry to Antrim Castle Gardens will be via Barbican Gate in Antrim Town Centre, gates will open from 4pm on Friday 7 December 2018.

- Pre booked ticket required or pay at entrance option available. Tickets bought at the entrance are subject to availability.
- Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Council requests that visitors assist in creating a shared event space. Therefore, Council reserves the right to restrict access to its events if it is deemed, by the Council, that a patron(s) is/are in breach of this position. Council also has a duty to ensure various equality rights are protected under section 75 of the Northern Ireland Act 1998, and reserves the right to restrict access to events should a patron(s) behave in a manner that is likely to constitute a breach of these obligations.
- Alcohol is not permitted to be brought on site.
- Young People under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Should you leave the event you may not be able to re-enter; this will be at the discretion of the stewards and may be dependent on the site reaching capacity.
- Dogs on leads will be permitted on site however please note there will be loud noises and bright lights, which may cause issues for dogs.
- No Bicycles permitted on site.
- No glass, hand held fireworks or naked flames permitted on site.
- Unauthorised charity collections, leafleting or other promotional activity are not permitted within the site.
- Please be aware that Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Council will have an official photographer on site. Each participant on entry to 'Enchanted Winter Garden' hereby grants to Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Council an exclusive, absolute and irrevocable worldwide assignment in perpetuity in the photographs/film/video/electronic representations and/or sound recordings of the participant obtained at the event and grants to Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Council the right to use and publish such content in any and all media. The participant hereby releases Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Council from any and all liability from such use and promotion. The participant hereby authorises the reproduction, sale, copyright, exhibit, broadcast, electronic storage and/or distribution of said photographs/film/video tapes/electronic representations and/or sound recordings without limitation at the discretion of Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Council. The participant specifically waives any right to any compensation they may have for appearing in any of the photographs/film/video/electronic representations and for sound recordings of the participant at 'Enchanted Winter Garden.'
- Once on site you assume all risk of injury and all responsibility for property loss, destruction or theft and release organisers, sponsors, performers, venue and their employees from any liability.
- Parking is not available within Antrim Castle Gardens. Please use the Town Centre public car parks. Please note some parking for Blue Badge holders is available in Castle Mall car park.
- While the event site is accessible, we would ask that you take caution underfoot on the grassed areas. Please wear sensible footwear and dress according to the weather conditions.
- Smoke effects, strobe lighting, lasers and loud noises may be used at this event.
- As per legislation and Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Council by-laws, UAVs/drones should not be operated within or in the vicinity of Antrim Castle Gardens. In such cases, authorities will be notified and further action will be taken.
- It is anticipated that this outdoor event will happen regardless of weather conditions so please dress accordingly. However, in extreme conditions it may be necessary to close the event.
- Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Council reserves the right to make any alterations to the advertised details for the event.
- Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Council reserve the right to refuse entry.
